

**INVITATION TO BID
2008 ROAD MAINTENANCE PROJECT**

**TOWN OF DOVER
RACINE COUNTY, WISCONSIN**

OWNER: The Town of Dover hereby gives notice that sealed bids will be received at the office of the Town Clerk for construction of the 2008 Road Maintenance Program:

Major work effort includes: full depth pulverization, subgrade repair, asphaltic concrete binder and surface pavement and aggregate shouldering of Raynor Avenue and Mealy Road.

TIME: Sealed Bids will be received until 10:00 A.M., local time, on June 5, 2008 at the office of the Clerk/Treasurer, Town of Dover, P. O. Box 670, 4110 S. Beaumont Avenue, Kansasville, Wisconsin, 53139, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read at the Town Hall.

The project consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools and labor necessary for the described work and other miscellaneous work as provided in the Contract Documents.

Contract will be awarded based on Total Bid Amount. Sections A, B, and/or C may be awarded or deleted from the contract award at Town Board's discretion

BIDDING DOCUMENTS: The Bidding Documents may be obtained from the office of Applied Technologies, Inc., 300 North Milwaukee Avenue, Suite E, Lake Villa, Illinois, 60046. Bidders shall include their name, address, telephone number, and FAX number with their request for Bidding Documents.

WAGE RATES: Contractors are required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates on the project as established by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Commerce pursuant to Section 66.293 of the Wisconsin Statutes. Copies of the prevailing wage rate determination will be on file at the office of the Clerk/Treasurer.

BID SECURITY: Bids shall be accompanied by a certified or bank check or a Bid Bond on the prescribed form payable to the Owner in an amount not less than 5% of the maximum Bid as guarantee, that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute and file the Agreement, Performance and Payment Bonds, and Insurance Certifications, as required by the Contract Documents, within 15 days after the Notice of Award.

BID REJECTION/ACCEPTANCE: The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the Bid or Bids, which best serve the interests of Owner. The letting of the work described herein is subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes.

BID WITHDRAWAL: No Bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the scheduled opening of the Bids without the consent of the Owner.
