

## INVITATION TO BID

### ARTESIAN AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS VILLAGE OF BIG BEND, WISCONSIN

**OWNER:** The Village of Big Bend hereby gives notice that sealed bids will be received for the construction of roadway improvements along Artesian Avenue.

**PROJECT:** Major work effort includes 12" depth pulverization, subgrade repair, installation of aggregate course and fly ash course, excavation for roadway widening and ditch repair, asphaltic concrete binder course and surface pavement course, aggregate shouldering, drainage tile installation and curb and gutter installation along approximately 1,320 feet of Artesian Avenue.

The project consists of furnishing all materials, equipment, tools and labor necessary for the described work and other miscellaneous work as provided in the Contract Documents. Contract will be awarded based on Total Bid Amount.

**TIME:** Sealed Bids will be received until 3:00 P.M., local time, on Thursday, June 5, 2008 at the Office of the Village Clerk at the Village Hall, W230 S9185 Nevins, Big Bend, Wisconsin, 53103, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

**BIDDING DOCUMENTS:** The Bidding Documents may be obtained from the office of Applied Technologies, Inc. 16815 West Wisconsin Avenue, Brookfield, Wisconsin 53005. Bidders shall include their name, address, telephone number, and FAX number with their request for Bidding Documents.

**SUBSURFACE INVESTIGATION REPORTS:** Included in the Contract Documents.

**WAGE RATES:** Contractors are required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates on the project as established by the State of Wisconsin, Department of Workforce Development, Equal Rights Division – Labor Standards Bureau, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes. Copies of the prevailing wage rate determination will be included in the Bidding Documents and Contract Documents.

**OTHER PROVISIONS:** The Contract letting shall be subject to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes.

In connection with the performance of work under this contract, the Contractor agrees not to discriminate against any employees or applicant for employment because of age, race, religion, color, handicap, sex, physical condition, developmental disability, or national origin. This provision shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff and termination; rates of pay or other forms of compensation; selection for training, including apprenticeship. The Contractor further agrees to post in conspicuous places, available for employees and applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provisions of this non-discrimination clause.

**BID SECURITY:** Bids shall be accompanied by a certified or bank check or a Bid Bond on the prescribed form payable to the Owner in an amount not less than 5% of the Total Bid Amount as guarantee, that if the Bid is accepted, the Bidder will execute and file the Agreement, Performance and Payment Bonds, and Insurance Certifications, as required by the Contract Documents, within 15 days after the Notice of Award.

**BID REJECTION/ACCEPTANCE:** The Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, waive any informalities in bidding or to accept the Bid or Bids, which best serve the interests of Owner.

**BID WITHDRAWAL:** No Bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the scheduled opening of the Bids without the consent of the Owner.
